1	I-89N, Exit 17, Milton, mile 3.2	6.3-6.7 miles	Northbound: Fairly continuous deciduous and evergreen screening along interstate with occasional glimpses through breaks in trees
2	I-89N, miles 3.2-8.6	3.8 miles	Northbound: Open view while crossing bridge over Lamoille River (not focus of attention for southbound travelers)
3	I-89N, miles 8.6-15.6	3.1 miles	Northbound: Views through trees to the right, focus is on the road ahead
4	I-89S, Exit 19, St. Albans, miles 6.2 - 7	3.2 miles	Southbound: Couple glimpses through trees
5	Route 7N, Milton, miles 2.5 - 2.8	4.5 miles	Open view over commercial buildings including car wash, then becoming intermittent views through trees
6	Route 7N, Milton, miles 4.3-4.4	3.5 miles	View over commercial stretch of downtown
7	Route 7N, Milton, mile 4.5	3.4 miles	Glimpse through trees, shopping structures, buildings
8	Route 7N, Milton, miles 5.5-6.2	2.4-2.5 miles	View of top of ridge over warehouse at Ice House Rd., view over dam and associated structures, open views over Arrowhead Lake for stretch of route 7 along lake.
9	Route 7N, Milton, miles 7.2-7.5	2.1-2.2 miles	Open view over farm fields
10	Route 7N, Georgia, miles 10.0-11.0	2.9-3.6 miles	Broad open landscape with views over interstate and farm fields
11	Route 7S, Georgia, mile 4.3	6.1 miles	Possible glimpse
12	Route 7S, Georgia, miles 6.1-6.9	4.3 miles	Views of northwest portion of ridge over farm fields and trees
13	Route 7S, Georgia, miles 7.0-7.2	3.6-4.1 miles	Intermittent views of northwest portion of ridge over farm fields and trees
14	Route 7S, Georgia, miles 7.4-7.6	3.2 miles	Views of northwest portion of ridge near Interstate interchange w/ overhead Interstate signage and some roadside commercial development in view. Park & Ride in view at southern side of interchange
15	Route 7S, Milton, miles 9.7-10.1	2.3 miles	Possible filtered views through deciduous trees in wintertime
16	Route 7S, Milton, miles 10.5-10.6	2.2 miles	Possible filtered views through deciduous trees in wintertime
17	Milton-Westford Road, East, miles .5-.7	2.2 miles	View over residential subdivision
18	Milton-Westford Road, East, miles .73-.83	1.9 miles	Intermittent views over residential subdivision through breaks in trees

35	Route 104, South, mile .2	2.5 miles	Views of Georgia Mountain to the west, competing with commanding view of Mt. Mansfield to east
36	Route 104, South, miles .8-1.35	2.5 miles	Intermittent views between buildings and trees in Fairfax Village
37	Route 128, South, mile 2.2	3.0 miles	Open view over athletic fields in foreground
38	Route 128, South, miles .4-.5	2.8-2.9 miles	Intermittent views- stretches not visible due to intervening topography / vegetation
39	Middle Road, Milton, North, miles 0-2.5	3.6-6.1 miles	Glimpses through roadside trees and residences
40	Middle Road, Milton, North, miles 2.5-3.0	3.7 miles	Open views above cemetery and between buildings
41	Hardscrabble Road, Milton	2.7-2.9 miles	Open views at intersection, trees block views at higher elevations on Devino Road

42	North Street, Milton, Northbound	1.4-2.1 miles	Open view over housing subdivision, view transitions to intermittent above trees and houses, and back to open views near Husky Industries. Remainder is intermittent views through trees and view eventually disappears behind roadside topography and trees
43	Spooner Road and Silver Lake Road, Southbound, Georgia	1.7-2.5 miles	Open views southbound. Orientation of road provides direct view
44	Industrial Park Road, Milton	1.9-3.0 miles	Intermittent views and glimpses above trees
45	Sam Webb Road, Fairfax, miles .0-1.9	2.5-4.2 miles	Eastbound driver is oriented away from view. Glimpses are visible above ridge and trees
46	Hanson and Buck Hollow Roads, Southbound, Fairfax	2.7-4.2 miles	Southbound has open views near intersection with Route 104
47	Osgood Hill Road, Westford	4.6-5.6 miles	Heavily wooded area , Georgia Mountain barely visible
48	Old Stage Road, Northbound, Essex	5.6-9.9 miles	Agricultural area with scattered homes and farms. On Westford portion of road the views are intermittent through trees
49	Mountain Road, Eastbound, Westford	2.8-3.1 miles	Heavily wooded residential area. Open views above houses is prominent because of proximity to turbine site
50	Old Stage Road, Northbound, Westford	2.3-2.8 miles	Intermittent views between trees with occasional open views as motorist nears Westford-Milton Road
51	Woods Hollow Road, Southbound, Westford	3.3-4.6 miles	Heavily wooded area and intervening topography allow few glimpses
52	Rollin Irish Road, Westbound, Westford	5.5-5.8 miles	No views due to intervening topography and trees
53	East Road, Northbound, Milton	2.7-5.5 miles	Open fields along stretches of road allow full views
54	Lake Road, Westbound, Milton, miles .0-3.2	2.3-4.6 miles	Lake Road is a residential area with suburban feeling. Views of project site are frequent between intervening structures and trees
55	Stone Bridge Road, Georgia	6.1 miles	Stone Bridge Road has intervening topography and residences
56	Plains Road, Eastbound, Georgia	5.5-6.2 miles	Occasional glimpses above ridgeline
57	Polly Hubbard, Westbound, Georgia	6.3-7.3 miles	Heavily wooded portions on eastern end of road allow no views. Nearing intersection with Middle Road there are working farms and open distant views of turbines
58	Pattee Hill Road, Westbound, Georgia	5.2-6.6 miles	Occasional views above trees
59	Georgia Middle Road, Southbound, Georgia	5.3-6.7 miles	Open farmlands allow distant views of turbines between existing transmission lines

63	Cadreact Road, Milton	6.4 miles	Working farmland, glimpses above ridgeline
64	Bear Trap Road, Milton	7.0 miles	Agricultural area with intervening topography and structures. View is to the east and road is oriented north to south.
65	East Road, Northbound, Colchester	6.6-8.8 miles	Intersection with of East Road and Route 2A is heavily traveled. Open views of turbine site are visible approximately 2 miles from intersection. Area has many houses and businesses.
66	Colchester Pond Boat Launch	8.1 miles	Colchester Pond Boat Launch has many existing transmission lines through the water. Distant possible views of tip of Georgia Mountain
