GMCW will provide an economic benefit, and it is a direct answer to the call to develop clean energy.

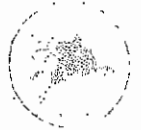




